**SABINE LIEBNER**

SABINE LIEBNER is active primarily as a performer of New Music. Numerous recordings for radio, television, and CDs as well as invitations to international festivals, both as soloist and as chamber musician, document her work as an artist. She has collaborated on projects with the composers Olga Neuwirth, Jörg Widmann, Franco Donatoni, and Christian Wolff, among others, and given numerous world and national premieres. She received the 1998 Grant-in-Aid for Music of the City of Munich, and in 2005 a Stipend for Music from the state capital. In 2007 she was named a recommended pianist by the Goethe Institute. In recent years Sabine Liebner's interests have focused on American composers of the twentieth century. Her repertoire of American music includes Henry Cowell, Earle Brown, Christian Wolff, Pauline Oliveros, and Tom Johnson. She plays nearly all of the piano works of John Cage and Morton Feldman. Sabine Liebner lives in Munich.
